

# Perth Transport Futures Project

## Phase 1 - A9/A85 Junction Improvement and Link Road to Bertha Park

### NEIGHBOUR NOTICE

As you will be aware Perth and Kinross Council have appointed Balfour Beatty as the Principal Contractor for the works to construct the first phase of the Perth Transport Futures Project.

This project includes construction of a new A9 junction with slip roads, a new link road to Bertha Park and a new junction on the A85.

Works in connection with the construction of a new culvert under the A9 for the Lade (at the location shown on the map opposite) will take place until the end of June 2017. Due to the complex construction, and the need to keep disruption to traffic on the A9 to a minimum, it will be necessary to extend normal working hours to include Saturday and Sunday working from 18 March to 25 June 2017. These additional hours will ensure that the contraflow on the A9 can be removed by the end of June 2017 before seasonal traffic flows increase. On a week to week basis as the work progresses endeavours will be made to reduce these hours or not work on the Sunday where possible dependant on progress of the works.

Whilst we acknowledge that there is likely to be some noise disruption and inconvenience associated with performing works outside normal site hours we will make every effort to keep this to a minimum, and apologise for this in advance. Noise monitoring will be undertaken during the course of the works to ensure these efforts are effective.
